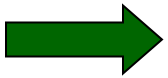

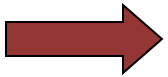

Medications for Opioid Use Disorder Programs

Medications for Opioid Use Disorder (MOUD)* in Livingston County

*MOUD includes three FDA-approved medications to treat opioid use disorder including methadone, buprenorphine (brand name Suboxone or long-acting injection Sublocade), and naltrexone (brand name Vivitrol). MOUD is also known as Medication Assisted Treatment (MAT).

It is important to remember that people do recover. Each person has their own way and their own resources that help them along the way. Sometimes getting involved in the solutions or having opportunities to act on efforts helps the person in recovery, as well as, their loved ones. Below are just a few of the efforts in the county that you can get involved in.

- **Livingston County Community Alliance (LCCA)**
